TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS

ACTIVE MEMBERS

An active member is an Individual or business actively involved in or retired as a designer, engineer, installer, pumper, operator, manager, maintenance provider, manufacturer, supplier, inspector, soil scientist, educator, or regulator whose dues are current. Active members are voting members of the Association (one vote per company).

STUDENT

A student member is an individual actively studying wastewater treatment or a closely related field at a college or vocational institution whose dues are current. Student members have no voting rights.

LIFE - TIME / HONORARY

An honorary member may be so appointed by the Board of Directors. Honorary members have no voting rights. A life-time member is a former active member designated by the Board of Directors. Each life-time member shall be entitled to one vote upon each matter submitted.
